- AAUW Scholarship Application: Completed and Signed
- A "Future Plans" essay of approximately 300 words should be included with the application.
- Official college transcripts should be submitted directly from most recent college and university attended. Transcripts should include grades from the Fall semester or quarter.
- Two letters of recommendation from faculty members must be submitted, one of which must be from a faculty member of the college or university you are currently attending.
- Proof of Residency: Applicants must be U.S. citizens or maintain permanent resident status and reside in San Diego County. (A copy of student or parent's utility bill is sufficient to show San Diego County residency requirement).
- Applicants must be attending or admitted for Fall of current year to a 4-year college or university in San Diego.
- Applicants must be full-time students (at least 12 units per semester or quarter).
- Applicants must be working toward a baccalaureate degree or a credential, but not a graduate degree.
- Applicants must have earned at least 60 semester (90 quarter) units of credit toward the baccalaureate degree, and have a grade point average of 3.4 or higher at college or university where currently enrolled.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All majors will be considered on an equal basis. After reviewing applications, the Scholarship Committee will select the finalists for the year's scholarship awards. Applicants who have been ranked as finalists will be contacted for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee. Awards will be in the range of \$750 to \$2000. Scholarship recipients will be honored by the San Diego Branch of AAUW at their AAUW San Diego annual June luncheon.

Previous recipients are ineligible to apply for a second scholarship, but are encouraged to apply for a Graduate Fellowship from AAUW in Washington, D.C.
